






Idaho CERCLA Disposal Facility


- ROD Signed in 1999
- RCRA Subtitle C / TSCA Chemical Waste Landfill
- 510,000 yd³ Capacity
- Waste Disposal Began in 2003
- On-site CERCLA Waste Only
- Mixed & Low-Level Wastes, Soils & Debris, Large Items

Tribal Coordination and Consultation

Tribal Coordination

- Sharing information, education, and outreach.
- Most often at staff level.
- Can be part of Consultation.
- Cannot substitute for Consultation.
- Often consists of regular meetings.





Tribal Consultation

- Process of meaningful communication and coordination between agency and Tribal officials.
- Taken prior to agency actions or implementing decisions that may affect Tribes.


