Weight-of-Evidence Decision Making for Munitions Response Sites

This 2-day course is based on the Munitions Response Quality Assurance Project Plan Toolkit Module 1: Remedial Investigation (RI)/ Feasibility Study (FS) and Module 2: Remedial Action (RA). The training demonstrates weight-of-evidence decision making for the RI/FS and RA phases at a munitions response site. It covers project planning, data quality objective development and data usability assessment.
