► INTENTIONS

The PFAS-team at COMMON FORUM likes to express the importance and need to initiate exchanges of views on the way forward to ensure health safety and environmental quality, good soil health and groundwater status, safe soil reuse and legal certainty for the PFAS contamination in soil and groundwater

- Approximately 4 meetings per year (usually online) with an average of 15 to 20 participants

• TOPICS

- determining the activities that can lead to contamination of the soil or groundwater with PFAS
- □ drawing up inventories of potentially PFAS contaminated sites
- □ investigation of the inventoried PFAS sites
- □ determining background values and trigger values for PFAS
- □ performing risk assessments for PFAS
- remediation of PFAS-contaminated soils
- □ investigation and approach for diffuse contamination of PFAS
- trigger values for reuse of soil and soil materials
- exchange with the PFAS working group of NICOLE

Cooperation 4 countries

Cooperation Germany, Denmark, Netherlands and Belgium (Flanders) – new initiative recently started – policy advisors and scientists

- Derivation of soil standards (trigger values and risk assessment) methodology and concepts
- Going from EFSA-4 to all PFAS: Risk Potention Factors, Risk Fate Factors
- Short chain PFAS discussion: measurement/analysis, environmental behaviour
- Sum PFAS discussion: 1/ measurement/analysis: EOF, TOPA, NTA,...; 2/ recommendation for use, sensitivity, LOQs,...; 3/ Which PFAS are in sum?
- Anthropogenic background, re-use of soils, link to groundwater, leaching
