The National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) has a requirement for processing and disposal services for a lead and steel neutron experiment shield, which is classified as low-level radioactive waste (LLRW). The shield is below 10CFR61.55 Class A limits. NIST has a U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC) "Radioactive Materials License" (SNM-362) and USNRC "Reactor License" (TR-5), and is authorized to possess by-product material in any chemical and/or physical form. The waste in this procurement conforms to acceptance criteria for the suggested methods of waste processing. The Contractor shall provide services for transportation, processing, volume reduction, shipping and burial document preparation, transport to burial site, and burial of the neutron experiment shield. A single shipment is expected. The LLRW is a single reactor component item consisting of primarily lead and then steel. The item weighs ~10,000 pounds. Low-level internal contamination and/or activation, with external contact dose rate less than 3 mr/hr. The item does not contain RCRA-hazardous materials. The activation products contained are primarily Co-60 and lead isotopes. The purpose of this notice is to determine the availability of qualified companies technically capable of meeting the Government's requirement and to help determine the method of acquisition. The Site consists of the Quivira CR-1 Mine, the Quivira CR-1E Mine, and three vent holes for the subsurface workings at the mines. The Quivira mines are abandoned uranium mines on the Navajo Reservation. The mines themselves are fenced and awaiting a final response action. Three vent holes located near the mines are accessible by the community and have levels of Radium-226 in the soil that was deposited by air venting from the subsurface mine workings. The area of contamination at each vent hole is approximately one-half acre. The typical concentration of Radium-226 is in the range of 4-10 pCi/g. There is one small waste pile with a maximum detection of 360 pCi/g. The site is located between Thoreau, NM, and Gallup, NM, on the Navajo reservation. A SITE VISIT WILL BE HELD AT 10:00 AM ON JULY 16, 2015. This Scope of Work is for excavation and earthwork activities. as is cooperation with external stakeholder groups. Located in southeastern Idaho, the 890-square-mile INL site encompasses one of the last remaining relatively undisturbed tracts of sagebrush steppe habitat. The INL site is currently operated for DOE by Battelle Energy Alliance. This RFP is for a follow-on contract effort; the current ESER contract is being performed by Gonzales-Stoller Surveillance, LLC of Idaho Falls, Idaho.
