Coast Guard Shore Infrastructure Logistic Center is procuring Indoor Firing Range Cleaning and Maintenance Services at U.S. Coast Guard Base Cape Cod, Buzzards Bay, Massachusetts. THIS REQUIREMENT IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The total contract value is estimated under \$1M. The contractor shall provide all labor, personnel, management, supervision, materials, supplies, and other items or services (except as stated in the scope of work) necessary to provide Indoor Firing Range Cleaning and Maintenance Services at USCG Base Cape Cod. The Government will award a contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible offeror with the Lowest Price Technically Acceptable Offer that conforms to the solicitation on a "Pass" or "Fail" basis. The anticipated contract award date is October 27, 2016, with the period of performance for the base period beginning on or about 1 November 1, 2016, through October 31, 2017, and with four one-year option periods, if exercised (November 1, 2017 - October 31, 2021). **NAICS:** 541620. This solicitation was previously announced in FedBizOpps under solicitation numbers W56ZTN-14-R-0005 and W56ZTN-15-R-0001. THE SOLICITATION NUMBER IS NOW W56ZTN-16-R-0002. Any correspondence regarding this requirement must cite the new solicitation number. COMPETITION FOR THIS SOLICITATION IS LIMITED TO ELIGIBLE 8(A) FIRMS. The Government intends to award multiple IDIQ contracts in which firm-fixed-price and/or cost-plus-fixed-fee task orders likely will be issued. The period of performance is three years (a one-year base with two one-year options). All offerors must be registered as an 8(a) business under NAICS Code 541620 with a size standard of \$14M. The objective of this effort is to provide basic environmental services to US Army Garrison Aberdeen Proving Ground's (APG) Directorate of Public Works - Environmental Division (DPW-ED) and to all tenants supported by DPW-ED in need of environmental services. The funding sources for this acquisition are therefore expected to vary, although the primary objective remains, regardless of the proponent or funding source, and that is to provide a variety of environmental support services required for APG to achieve its collective missions. The contractor shall provide a wide range of Environmental Services to include facility maintenance activities or construction and demolition or both to comply with environmental laws and regulations at properties within the control of APG and Garrison-supported organizations (GSOs). The Contractor shall execute work to meet the objectives/milestones in specific task order performance work statements. The contractor shall perform munitions response activities that may involve the remediation and disposition of munitions and explosives of concern, which include unexploded ordnance, discarded military munitions, and munitions constituents. Pursuant to the 2012 Defense Environmental Restoration Program Manual, munitions responses will follow the CERCLA process under the Military Munitions Response Program. In addition, the contractor may perform quantitative assessments on operational ranges that will provide information necessary to keep the ranges open for training and testing. The contractor may perform investigations to determine if there has been a release of munitions constituents of concern (MCO) to an off-range area and off-range release of MCO that might pose an unacceptable risk to human health or the environment. **NAICS:** 562910. The official solicitation for EPA's Remediation Environmental Services (RES) acquisition was posted

September 16, 2016, on FedConnect. Under Documentation, the folder containing the solicitation files (SOL-HQ-14-00023 and attachments 1-8 and 10-11) follows the Pre-Solicitation folder. Be advised that the folder that immediately follows, labeled Amendment 1, contains attachments 9 and 12. Attachment 1--RES Performance Work Statement--describes the five functional (task) areas: 1. General Requirements; 2. Field Work and Analytical Support; 3. Remedial Action or Removal Action Implementation; 4. EPA-lead Remedy Operation including Long Term Response Action; and 5. Engineering Support. The General Requirements section calls for attention to Greener Cleanups and Climate Change Considerations; Clean Diesel Requirements; and Renewable Energy Considerations, among other considerations. See also the file labeled RES Questions and Answers, provided in response to contractor questions about the RES Draft Solicitation. The Government intends to make award to approximately seven contractors for each contract line item number (CLIN) from this solicitation, with a reserve of three IDIQ contracts for small businesses, for Remediation Environmental Services under NAICS code 562910. EPA may adjust the total number of awards based on the quality and quantity of proposals received. The Offeror shall submit a proposal for each CLIN they are proposing on; however, only one proposal will be accepted from each Offeror per CLIN. An offeror will be eligible to receive an award for only one contract in response to this solicitation. A contractor can be awarded more than one CLIN, but will still receive only one contract award. Work under each contract will be performed independently of and simultaneously with work under the other contracts. EPA intends to award contracts to those firms that can provide coverage to the entire CLIN. Questions regarding the solicitation are due by October 5, at 4:30 PM ET. PROPOSALS ARE DUE BY 4:30 PM ET ON NOVEMBER 4, 2016.

**NAICS:** 562211. The Federal Bureau of Investigation has awarded a Sole-Source, short-term bridge purchase order to Range Maintenance, Inc. (RMI), located at PO Box 753 - 407 Webb Road - Chadds Ford, PA 19317-0622 for lead cleaning, abatement services and supplies for the FBI Academy in Stafford, VA. It has been determined that RMI is the only source who can provide this unique service in a timely fashion. A quote has been solicited and awarded under DJF-16-2100-PR-0003908 for six months. Six 30-day option periods have been solicited but not awarded. Option periods will only be awarded on an as-needed basis to allow sufficient time for a competitive solicitation and award process. This is a firm-fixed-price contract. Based on FBI market research, it has been determined that RMI is the only source to meet FBI requirements and no other supplies or services will satisfy the agency requirements in a timely fashion. A competitive solicitation package is expected to be posted no later than November 30, 2016.
