The intent of this contract is to provide comprehensive A-E services to various Navy and other DoD installations/organizations worldwide in order to meet statutory compliance requirements for all applicable Overseas Environmental Baseline Guidance Document (OEBGD), Final Governing Standards (FGS), DoD, federal, state, local, and installation-specific environmental laws, regulations, and guidance. This procurement will result in one IDIQ contract for multi-discipline A-E water compliance services in the Naval Facilities Engineering Command's Atlantic area of responsibility, but may also include work worldwide. The principal geographic area includes the continental United States and Navy Region Europe. The IDIQ contract will be for a base period of one year and four one-year option periods (if exercised).
