DOE's Office of Environmental Management (EM) is currently in the acquisition planning stage for the potential contract award to complete the Phase 1B Deactivation & Demolition (D&D) and Soil Remediation activities at DOE's West Valley Demonstration Project (WVDP) Site in western New York. Under the Record of Decision for NEPA, Phase 1 represents the first phase for decommissioning of the WVDP in accordance with the WVDP Act (Public Law 96-368). Phase 1 Decommissioning work has been ongoing at WVDP since August 2011 when the Phase 1 Decommissioning-Facility Disposition contract was awarded to CH2M Hill-BWXT West Valley LLC. The purpose of the potential end-state contract is to achieve significant reduction in financial liability and environmental risk that provides the best overall optimal solution to site accelerated completion and closure. NAICS: 562112. THIS REQUIREMENT WILL BE A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. This notice is an RFQ for hazardous waste collection and disposal in accordance with the Statement of Work. The Pike-San Isabel National Forest has a requirement to collect and dispose of hazardous material and contaminated soil left over from the abandoned Peekaboo Mine. The mine is approximately 8 miles up a high-clearance 4WD road off Highway 82 before you go up to Independence Pass. The site is near the road, but not directly accessible with a vehicle. The containers of unknown substances must be packaged properly and carted over a temporary bridge back to the dirt road to be hauled out to the main road. This is not an easily accessible job site. Project magnitude is estimated to be well less than \$25,000. Contract performance period is July 15-July 31, 2019. COR will accompany Contractor throughout entire hazardous waste collection. This project is currently unfunded and is subject to the availability of funding. A non-mandatory pre-bid site visit is tentatively scheduled for Oct 22. DOE's Richland Operations Office (RL) needs uninterrupted cleanup activities and waste and spent nuclear fuels management, for the period of October 1, 2018, through September 30, 2019. RL currently contracts with the CH2M Hill Plateau Remediation Company (CHPRC) under Contract DE-AC06-08RL14788 for these services. The competitively awarded contract

included a 5-year base period and one 5-year option period. DOE complied with the CICA requirements in FAR, Part 6 for both the original contract award and exercise of the option in September 2013.
