Magnitude of Construction: \$25,000 - \$100,000. The proposed NAICS 562910 is applicable to this acquisition, size standard of \$20.5M. The contractor shall provide all labor and materials including tools and apparatus, equipment, supervision, certifications, licenses, permits, regulatory notifications, transportation, and disposal necessary to perform asbestos abatement work at the Richmond VAMC. All work shall be performed by state-licensed abatement contractors using EPA-accredited, state-certified, or state-licensed workers and supervisors. Contractor and employee training and certifications shall be commensurate to work performed and with requirements for licensing. All asbestos disposal facilities performing under this contract shall, at all times possess the applicable federal, state, and local regulatory approvals, and each asbestos disposal facility shall be approved in advance in writing by the Contracting Officer's Representative. This notice is a combined synopsis/solicitation for Hazardous Waste Removal Service (NAICS code 562112) for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and NIOSH located at 1095 Willowdale Road, Morgantown, WV 26505. The CDC intends to award a firm-fixed-price contract. NIOSH in Morgantown, WV, is a basic science research facility and a Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste. NIOSH currently has approximately 10,000 different chemicals in relatively small quantities. They are all hazardous, but not radioactive. NIOSH generates on average, 500 lbs. of hazardous waste (regulated + universal) per month. NIOSH requires a hazardous waste pick-up 3-4 times per year. Contractor services shall include pick-up, transportation, labeling, analyses, fate determination, documentation, and audit trails until ultimate treatment or disposal of hazardous or toxic wastes. The intention is to procure these services on a competitive basis. Based on the responses to this request for information, this requirement may be set aside for small businesses (in full or in part) or procured through full and open competition. All small business set-aside categories will be considered. At this time the Baltimore District requests capability statements only from any Small Business, certified 8(a), certified HUBZone, Economically Disadvantaged Woman-Owned Small Business, and Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business. The applicable NAICS code for this requirement is 562910 (Environmental Remediation Services), small business size standard 750 employees. The requirement is for an Environmental Services contract to support the Air Force at JBA, MD, in executing its Environmental Restoration Program via a performance-based ORC. The work will consist of performance of environmental activities necessary for site investigation, engineering design, remedial action, remedial construction, and long-term monitoring to achieve minimum performance objectives and stretch goals and support progress to Site Closeout at up to 22 Installation Restoration Program (IRP) and nine Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) sites in various phases of remediation. The USACE Omaha District is requesting industry comments or concerns regarding the draft RFP for a potential acquisition. At this time, the future acquisition is expected to be issued as an 8(a) set-aside under NAICS code 562910 (Environmental Remediation Services), size standard 750 employees. Please do not submit a proposal in response to this draft RFP. A formal RFP under the same solicitation number will be released at a later DATE YET TO BE DETERMINED. The Government does not intend to respond to any comments but will review and consider comments and concerns received in the development of the final RFP. The potential contract awarded under this solicitation likely will be an IDIQ contract for immediate/rapid response under NAICS Code 562910, in support of the USACE Omaha District and its customers (Continental United States, Alaska, Hawaii, and U.S. outlying areas). The contract awarded will include both cost-reimbursable and firm-fixed-price features for remediation of various hazardous waste sites as identified in Section C (Scope of Work) of the attachment at FedBizOpps. The contract will have a base performance period of three years plus one 2-year option, or until the \$35M contract limit is reached, whichever occurs first.
