The U.S. Geological Survey plans to issue a Request for Quotation (RFQ #140G0318Q0034) for a project involving the drilling and installation of a groundwater monitoring well in the relatively remote area of Pigeon Canyon in Northern Arizona. The Arizona Water Science Center in Tucson is in need of a contractor experienced with the installation of groundwater monitoring wells in consolidated deposits in Northern Arizona. A single perched groundwater monitoring well is needed as part of a groundwater water-quality study that will monitor possible contributions from the former Pigeon uranium mine to elevated uranium concentrations at Pigeon Spring. The monitoring well will 1) monitor water levels in the well to obtain local information on the direction of perched groundwater flow, and 2) monitor water quality in the well to compare with water chemistry at Pigeon Spring. The depth of the well is expected to be about 550 feet. The estimated magnitude of construction project is between \$25,000 and \$100,000. THE GOVERNMENT ANTICIPATES RELEASING THE RFQ ON OR ABOUT FEBRUARY 23, 2018, with a proposal due date of March 20, 2018. The anticipated date for contract performance is flexible, to be coordinated and mutually agreed after contract award, so long as the project is completed by September 30, 2018.
