Important components of the activities to be performed to support OW's objectives are the capability to provide professional services to develop, revise, and implement ecological criteria for the protection of water quality on a national, state, and site-specific basis. This technical and regulatory support requires experience in aquatic toxicology, aquatic chemistry, sediment toxicology, ecotoxicology, statistics, bioaccumulation, nutrients and nutrification, biological assessment, biocriteria, aquatic biology, wildlife toxicology, suspended and bedded sediments, biosolids risk assessment, fate and effects and transport modeling, geochemical speciation modeling, aquatic life criteria development, and other human health and ecological criteria development derivation procedures. It is anticipated that the contract will be a single award IDIQ contract with a 5-year ordering period with one additional year for task completion, plus an option to extend services for up to 6 months. The government is still considering which task order type(s) will be utilized, and is contemplating firm-fixed-price, time-and-materials, and cost-plus-fixed-fee task orders.
