THIS SOLICITATION IS A WOMAN-OWNED SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE, NAICS code 562910 (size standard 750 employees), for erosion control and repair at the Mesa II Mine Site located in the Cove Chapter of the Navajo Nation, Apache County, AZ. The scope of work includes activities for erosion control/repair and excavation/consolidation of radiological contaminated soils associated with the Mesa II Mine site. The work will include planning, contaminated soil consolidation, road grading, reclamation channel repair and stabilization, soil work (excavation, loading, transporting, stockpiling, and backfilling), and seeding, surveying, compaction, testing, and erosion control measures. IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THE PROCUREMENT WILL BE SOLICITED USING FULL-AND-OPEN COMPETITION under NAICS code 541620 (Environmental Consulting Services), small business size standard \$15M. This upcoming solicitation will provide technical assistance services to the Warm Springs Tribe to include training, O&M troubleshooting, and planning support in order to restore and maintain compliance with the discharge limits of their NPDES permits. The Warm Springs Tribe operates four community wastewater treatment systems: Warm Springs Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP), Kahneeta Lagoons, Simnasho Lagoons (non-discharging), and Sunnyside Lagoons (non-discharging). The services to be provided under the resulting contract are focused mainly on the Warm Springs WWTP located in Warm Springs, OR. The period of performance will be 365 calendar days after issuance of award.
