The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) - Energy requires the performance of thermal remediation activities at seven former bulk field-constructed underground storage tanks (BFCUSTs) within the South Tank Farm Area at Defense Fuel Support Point (DFSP) San Pedro, CA, in order to obtain a No Further Action decision. Each BFCUST, surrounding treatment area, and contaminated plume zone is defined as a Site. The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement's Western Region Federal Reclamation Program (WR-FRP) requires the services of a geotechnical engineering firm to provide Architecture and Engineering design services for the reclamation of hazardous abandoned coal mine sites. The features at the abandoned coal mine sites primarily consist of open shafts, portals, and mine-related subsidences. Other hazards may include mine gas venting, mine fires, mine facilities, and unstable high walls. These abandoned mine land (AML) features can be classified as either an Emergency (sudden danger that has a high probability of causing substantial physical harm before it can be abated under normal program operation procedures) or High Priority, as defined in Section 403 of the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977. Emergency features will also require design services under this Scope of Work. Generally, the engineering work will include site investigations; exploratory drilling or excavation; sampling and analysis of mine gases and mine drainage; surveys, development of site maps, and historic mine map research; development of reclamation design alternatives; design development for the selected alternative; identification of environmental effects of the proposed construction; technical support for obtaining environmental permits; preparation of construction plans and specifications; construction cost estimating; participation in public pre-bid, and pre-construction meetings; monitoring of construction activities; preparation of reports for the various tasks completed; and other work elements as specified in the Delivery Orders. Each Delivery Order will specify the work elements to be completed for each project. The WR-FRP is responsible for reclaiming AML sites in non-program states and tribes, or states and tribes that do not have their own AML Coal Program. These abandoned coal mine sites are primarily located in the State of Washington and potentially in California, Oregon, Arizona, South Dakota, and on Reservation Lands affected by historic coal mining.
