The FFAs will remain separate. Regulatory oversight at JBER is provided by U.S. EPA Region 10 and ADEC. The JBER Installation Restoration Program (IRP) is required to implement remedies as necessary to enable the mission, protect human health and the environment, and comply with laws. The goal of the Optimized Remediation Contract (ORC) initiative is to ensure the JBER IRP continues to fulfill all facets of its Environmental Restoration Program (ERP) mission, while effectively and efficiently managing the program in a performance-based, results-oriented, and cost conscious framework. The intent of the ORC initiative is to advance site cleanup during the period of performance in the most efficient and cost-effective manner as supported by a business case analysis that achieves the greatest reduction in life-cycle cost (LCC). The Contractor will analyze for possible substantial reduction of long-term environmental liabilities and LCCs through optimization of environmental restoration activities for all sites included in this contract while complying with applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations and applicable base-specific orders, agreements, or rules.
