At the current time, a total of 1936 capsules containing radioactive Cs-137 and Sr-90 are in storage in the WESF pool cells. The WESF G-cell is used for polishing, engraving, and inspecting capsules. Currently, it contains a storage tank as a recovery option if a capsule were to fail. G-cell entry requires contamination area dress and no mask for entry. The windows have been exposed to very little radiation since they were last installed; therefore, the risk for dielectric discharge is expected to be low. No capsules are stored in G-cell and radiation levels are low. Contractor shall provide technically qualified person(s) that work as part of a team under the general supervision of CHPRC. Contractor employee(s) shall be responsible for independently planning, organizing, and performing a wide variety of non-hazardous specialized administrative/technical duties in support of the successful completion of the refurbishment work.
