## **F -- ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION MAIDIQ (ERMA FY23) (SRCSGT)**

**NAICS:** 562910. THIS IS A SOURCES SOUGHT NOTICE for market research purposes only. The U.S. Department of the Army's Mission and Installation Contracting Command seeks capable and interested contractors to provide a broad-spectrum of environmental remediation services at various Installations/locations throughout the contiguous United States (CONUS) and Puerto Rico, Hawaii, and Alaska. Contractors must have the capabilities and experience to perform or provide a wide range of evaluation, investigation, and other remediation services required for sites involving hazardous/toxic waste including per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) and perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), hereafter referred to as PFAS/PFOA, contaminants as identified by Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) policy. The Contractor shall also perform munitions response activities that may involve the remediation and the disposition of munitions and explosives of concern (MEC), which included unexploded ordnance (UXO), discarded military munitions (DMM), and munitions constituents (MC). In addition, the Contractor shall perform Operational Range Assessments (ORA) on operations ranges to provide information on potential migration of munitions constituents of concern (MCO) off operational ranges (necessary to support continuity of training and testing). The Contractor shall not perform chemical warfare material (CWM) work; however, the Contractor shall be familiar with and be able to recognize CWM to be able to stop work and notify the Army of these potential hazards. Be advised that the U.S. Government will not be able to set aside this requirement if two or more small businesses do not respond with information to support the set-aside nor consider an unrestrictive suite if not enough large businesses respond to this notice with their capability statements. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers seeks to identify qualified sources to perform Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) responses involving conventional munitions; Environmental Compliance and Remediation Services (ECRS); and Other Munitions-Related Services (OMRS), as necessary to enable lands and waters to be safely and efficiently used for their intended purposes. This contract is intended to support sites located throughout the United States, including Alaska and Hawaii, the U.S. Territories, U.S. Territorial waters and Outlying areas as defined by FAR 2.101. The services provided under this contract will be used in support of various Department of Defense Commands and Installations and other federal agencies.
