## **F -- ASBESTOS ABATEMENT (COMBINE)**

**NAICS:** 562910. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of Agriculture, Agriculture Research Service, requires a contractor for the proper removal, disposal, and air clearance of asbestos from its Egg Safety and Quality Research Unit (ESQRU) facility in Athens, Georgia. The areas involved include laboratory hood panels, sinks, and countertops. The work must be supervised by a certified asbestos abatement supervisor; workers must conduct the work in full personal protective equipment. All asbestos removed will be wrapped in two 6mil plastic and labeled to be disposed of in a state-approved landfill. Amended water (surfactant) will be used at all times to keep the asbestos-containing material wet. The Government anticipates the award of a firm-fixed-price contract with a period of performance from August 22 through October 22, 2022. The award will be based on the Lowest-Priced Technically Acceptable (LPTA) method. OFFERS ARE DUE BY 4:00 PM CDT ON AUGUST 19, 2022.

## **F -- EINSTEIN MINE SITE INSPECTION, US FOREST SERVICE, MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOREST (COMBINE)**

**NAICS:** 541990. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of Agriculture Forest Service requires a contractor to perform a Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) Site Inspection (SI) at the Einstein Mine Site located in the Mark Twain National Forest (MTNF) in Madison County, Missouri. The Einstein Mine Site is an abandoned lead/silver mine that began operation in the 1870s and is believed to contain surface level tailings with high lead (Pb) concentrations. It is managed by the U.S. Forest Service. There has been minimal work in the past to evaluate the extent of contamination due to mining activities and any potential release of contaminants. The purpose of the SI is to determine if onsite soil contamination exists and its extent. The SI activity shall include soil sampling and producing an SI report. The sampling will include incremental sampling methodology (ISM) soil sample collection to be processed and analyzed in a laboratory to evaluate an unbiased estimate of the mean concentration of the COCs in soil. The work includes field collection of 29 soil samples along with 12 QA replicates for a total of 41 field samples with 30 aliquots each. The award will be a firm-fixed-price contract with a period of performance from award through September 2023. OFFERS ARE DUE BY 5:00 PM CDT ON AUGUST 26, 2022.

#### **B -- CA-SONNY BONO SS-SITE ASSESSMENT (COMBINE)**

**NAICS:** 541620. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has a requirement for site investigation and assessment of a former small arms firing range at the Sonny Bono Salton SEA National Wildlife Refuge Complex in Calipatria, California, which is 40 miles north of the Mexican border at the southern end of the Salton Sea. The purpose of this requirement is to characterize the site, identify potential environmental concerns, delineate and assess the vertical and lateral extent of potential contamination in the area, and recommend cleanup, removal, and mitigation activities that may need to be performed for decommissioning. The award will be a firm-fixed-price contract with a one-year base period of performance anticipated to start on September 1, 2022. A site visit is scheduled for this requirement on August 18, 2022, at Sonny Bono Salton Sea National Wildlife Refuge Complex at 906 West Sinclair Rd, Calipatria, CA 92233. **NAICS:** 562211. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of the Air Force, Air Education and Training Command, seeks a contractor that can provide hazardous material, waste, or substance spill response as well as remediation support for all Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) and its geographical separating locations. The scope of work shall include, but not be limited to, remediation (on soil and/or water), transportation, disposal, and, in the case in which there is a threat of a discharge, actions that may be necessary to minimize or mitigate damage to public health and the environment. The Contractor shall also provide additional assets as required. The Contractor shall have 24-hour, 365 days a year, emergency response coverage and be a U.S. Coast Guard certified Oil Spill Removal Organization (OSRO) qualified in river/canal and inland operating environments for both facilities and vessels and provide proof that they are OSRO qualified. **NAICS:** 562910. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of Agriculture Forest Service requires pre-demolition abatement services at the Midewin Tall Grass Prairie (TGP) located in Wilmington, Illinois. All Asbestos Containing Material (ACM) inspections under this contract must be performed and signed by an Illinois Licenced ACM inspector to satisfy State of Illinois EPA requirements prior to demolition. ACM may include roofing, siding, floor tile, mastic, or other building materials. All ACM, PCB-containing, or other special waste materials found in listed buildings and structures in the buildings must be removed and disposed of offsite. It is the responsibility of the contractor to divert as much waste as possible away from the landfill. The award will be a firm-fixed-price contract with a period of performance of 120 calendar days. The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Disposition Service requires the removal, transportation, and disposal of RCRA hazardous wastes, non-RCRA wastes, State-Regulated wastes, Non-State Regulated wastes, Universal Wastes, Compressed Gases, and Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) and Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) located on or around military installations or within a 50-mile radius of any pickup point listed on the contract in the State of California. The award will be a firm-fixed-price indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity (IDIQ) performance-based contract with a 30-month base period from December 2022 to April 2024 and a 30-month option period. The U.S. Department of Defense Logistics Agency, Energy Command, requires environmental compliance, environmental restoration, and environmental facility maintenance services at Defense Fuel Support Point (DFSP) Point Loma, California, including operation and maintenance of existing remedial systems, facility groundwater monitoring and reporting, data management services and professional services (project management and technical support). ## **F -- MCCLELLAN AFB RADIOLOGICAL REMEDIATION (PRESOL)**

**NAICS:** 562910. WHEN THE SOLICITATION IS RELEASED, IT WILL BE COMPETED AS AN 8(A) SET-ASIDE. The 772nd Enterprise Sourcing Squadron/Specialized Services Flight (772 ESS/PKS) in conjunction with the Air Force Civil Engineer Center (AFCEC), at Joint Base San Antonio-Lackland, TX, is contemplating a firm-fixed-price contract to complete the remediation of radiological material from Old Magpie Creek Channel. The scope of this work will focus on the testing, excavation, disposal, and unrestricted release of the property from the State of California. This effort is a validated FY22 requirement and funds are currently available. The period of performance (POP) is estimated at 36 months from the date of award. The Government reserves the right to cancel this requirement at any time. Should the Air Force determine to proceed with this requirement, it will be processed using FAR Part 36 and 37 procedures and will result in a Firm Fixed Price (FFP), "C" type contract. A formal solicitation will be finalized and posted to sam.gov at a later date.
