NAICS: 562211. THIS IS A FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION. The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Disposition Service requires the removal, transportation, incineration or other thermal treatment, and final disposal of containerized RCRA hazardous wastes (HW), non-RCRA wastes, PCB wastes, state, and non-state regulated wastes generated by U.S. Department of

Defense (DoD) and U.S. Coast Guard installations located in the 11 contiguous states of Arkansas, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, and Texas. A non-exhaustive list of potential pickup locations for waste removals (and limited other services) is provided in Attachment 3 of this contract. While the pickup locations identified in the attachment are listed under separate corresponding DLA contracts, the Contractor under this contract will be conducting business solely with and on behalf of the Government. The Government may add new pickup locations within the region at any time during the life of the contract. Every Task Order issued under this contract will require the Contractor to provide waste removal within 30 business days at one pickup location identified in, or subsequently added to the awarded contract. The award will be a firm-fixed-price indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity (IDIQ) performance-based contract with an 18-month base period and one 18-month option period. OFFERS ARE DUE BY 3:00 PM EST ON DECEMBER 19, 2022.

F -- FORMER HARSHAW CHEMICAL SITE REMEDIATION (FUSRAP) (PRESOL)

NAICS: 562910. WHEN THE SOLICITATION IS RELEASED ON OR AROUND APRIL 2023, IT WILL BE COMPETED AS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District is preparing a solicitation with the intent to award a C-type contract for remediation services at Former the Harshaw Chemical Company Site in Cleveland, Ohio. The technical scope of this anticipated contract identifies activities needed to remediate FUSRAP-contaminated soils at the site in accordance with the Record of Decision of Operable Unit-1 and Operable Unit-2. It is anticipated the result of the solicitation will be one C-type Hybrid Contract containing both Cost Reimbursable and Firm-Fixed Price line items. The award will be a Best Value procurement with an anticipated period of performance of three years from the award. A site visit will be announced when the solicitation is released.
