The U.S. Department of the Interior, National Park Service, is seeking information from firms, including small businesses, interested in providing a demolition inspection for regulated/hazardous building materials in support of the proposed demolition of the existing building located at the Boston National Historical Park in Boston, Massachusetts. This work will include the development of a complete inventory of regulated/hazardous abandoned building materials and other regulated items that may be stored within the existing building, culminating in the cataloging of the regulated/hazardous materials identified and a final report that includes budgetary disposal costs. A pre-renovation Hazardous Materials Survey was performed on February 22, 2019. Lead paint and asbestos were found within the building. PCBs were not detected. This SOW addresses abandoned printing equipment and objects in the building, not the building structure itself. A firm-fixed-price contract for this work is being considered. There is no solicitation at this time. Responses will be used to establish if this requirement can be set-aside for small businesses or other socioeconomic programs. F -- HAZARDOUS WASTE REMOVAL / DISPOSAL FOR THE MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST (COMBINE)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of Agriculture Forest Service requires the removal and disposal of the Stonyford House within Mendocino National Forest in Stonyford, California. Work will be conducted in two phases. Phase 1 efforts will be broken into two parts. Phase 1 Part A will consist of the removal of household hazardous waste, non-household hazardous waste, asbestos-containing material, and electronic waste in varying quantities to minimize, to the extent practicable, threats to human health, the environment, and damage to salvageable property. Phase 1 Part B will consist of the removal of readily accessible site debris. After completion of Phase 1 activities, the contractor will complete Phase 2, which includes debris, ash, and contaminated soil removal and disposal following Cal-EPA guidelines. The demolition work conducted in Phase 2 will be discontinued if suspected asbestos-containing material is encountered. Demolition work will not resume until the suspected asbestos-containing material or asbestos-containing material has been analyzed, the required regulatory notification has been completed, and the confirmed asbestos-containing material has been properly abated.
