Z -- ASBESTOS ABATEMENT (COMBINE)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of the Air Force requires a contractor to perform asbestos-abatement services at the 402 Commodities Maintenance Group (CMXG) at Robins Air Force Base in Georgia. The asbestos pipe insulation, asbestos debris on the roof and mezzanine, and heavy metals need to be cleaned. The project includes the removal of asbestos pipe insulation, and fallen asbestos debris, cleaning of heavy metals residue, and containment disposal. The area for repair is 40' x 23' with two pipes 40' (ft) each. The entire area (40' x 23') will need to be abated and cleaned. The award will be a firm-fixed-price contract with a two-week period of performance. OFFERS ARE DUE BY 4:00 PM EDT ON MAY 9, 2025.

F -- BUILDING REMEDIATION SERVICES (SOL)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION. The National Guard Bureau requires a contractor to clean and restore the Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) of Building 505 to Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standards, at Kingsley Field Air National Guard Base, Oregon. The Building 505 HVAC ducting and air handler requires remediation services to remove all foreign debris and contaminants, including: Arsenic, Barium, Cadmium, Chromium, Lead, Selenium, Silver, and Silica. The HVAC system is 128 linear feet of ducting, 120 linear feet of pipe, 2 plenums, and one air handler unit (AHU). F -- IL-CRAB ORCHARD NWR-ASBESTOS ABATEMENT (SOL)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The Fish and Wildlife Service requires a contractor to provide asbestos abatement services at the Fisheries Building in Marion, Illinois. The asbestos abatement work includes but is not limited to the abatement of approximately 600 square feet of Hard Plaster Walls with 3% chrysotile asbestos in kitchen area of Office; 4,000 square feet of 9" x 9" floor tile and mastic with 6% and 3% chrysotile

asbestos respectively throughout building; approximately 10 square feet of 12" x 12" floor tile mastic with 3% chrysotile asbestos in Women's Restroom; approximately 4,000 square feet of blown-in insulation with pipe insulation debris with 2% chrysotile asbestos throughout attic; approximately 3,000 square feet of transite siding with 15% chrysotile and 3% crocidolite asbestos on exterior of building; approximately 500 square feet of corrugated transite panel with 20% chrysotile asbestos on roof of building; approximately 255 square feet of 4' x 8' transite panels with 20% chrysotile asbestos on the ceiling. This work will not be measured for payment and shall be performed on a lump sum basis. A site visit will be held on May 13, 2025, at 10 AM CST. Z -- CATM RANGE MAINTENANCE BARKSDALE, AFB, LA (COMBINE)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of the Air Force requires a contractor to perform maintenance of the firing range at the Combat Arms Training and Maintenance (CATM) compound, Building 6571, on Barksdale AFB in Louisiana. The maintenance shall be performed every quarter within the 12-month period of performance. Personnel performing the maintenance shall be fully trained to perform preventative maintenance checks of all equipment associated with the firing range and fully trained to clean hazardous debris and residue. Contractor personnel shall have a working knowledge of how the bullet trap system works, to include the ability to repair the auger, auger motor, DCU, and associated equipment used to keep the bullet trap operational. Additionally, contractor personnel shall be required to fix all mechanical issues associated with the bullet trap/auger system/DCU. Personnel shall wear the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE). The contractor shall inspect bullet trap plates, baffle traps, joint strips, deflectors, and chambers for wear. The contractor shall test the air compressor and air lines for leaks and change oil as needed and/or according to the manufacturer's guidance. Disposal of all removed components shall be the contractor's responsibility, and the Government encourages recycling, if possible. Copies of weight tickets for any large items recycled shall be turned in to the Technical Focal Point (TFP). OFFERS ARE DUE BY 12:00 PM EDT ON JUNE 2, 2025.
