F -- YAKUTAT BLDG 101 REMOVAL ACTION (PRESOL)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE PRESOLICITATION NOTICE. The U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration, seeks capability statements from qualified small business contractors interested in performing a Removal Action (RA) at Building 101 near Yakutat Airport in Yakutat, Alaska. The work requires the excavation and disposal of up to 800 tons of petroleum-contaminated soil that exceeds applicable cleanup criteria. Contaminated soils are primarily located 4-8 feet below ground surface, with some impacts extending to the surface and down to 10 feet. The project includes working around multiple utilities in and near the excavation area, managing groundwater encountered at approximately 5-6 feet below ground surface, excavating through and restoring a 6,500-square-foot laydown/pad area, and temporarily removing and replacing semi-mobile trailers and utility hookups. Work must be completed during July/August 2026 to coincide with seasonal low-water levels. CAPABILITY STATEMENTS ARE DUE BY 12:00 PM CDT ON MAY 18, 2026.

F -- ASBESTOS ABATEMENT FOR 1 BUILDING AT TOBYHANNA ARMY DEPOT (SOL)

NAICS: 562910. THIS IS A SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of the Army requires a contractor to remove an inactive steam system at Tobyhanna Army Depot. The scope of work includes abatement, air monitoring and analysis, and the removal and disposal of asbestos-containing material (ACM) that is insulating the system. The steam system consists of approximately 400 linear feet of piping insulated with Air-o-Cel thermal insulation, as well as five steam heater units that must also be removed and properly disposed of. The period of performance for this requirement is 180 days. OFFERS ARE DUE BY 4:30 PM EDT ON MAY 18, 2026.

NAICS: 562910. WHEN THIS SOLICITATION IS RELEASED ON OR ABOUT MARCH 21, 2026, IT WILL BE COMPETED AS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The 772nd Enterprise Sourcing Squadron PKB Flight intends to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the Environmental Construction Optimization Services (ECOS) Multiple Award Task Order Contract (MATOC) / Indefinite-Delivery/Indefinite-Quantity (IDIQ) contract. This requirement is for comprehensive environmental services to support mission requirements. The broad scope of work encompasses environmental planning, investigation, remediation, construction, and compliance activities.
