The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service seeks a contractor to remove and dispose of approximately 1,550 square feet of non-friable asbestos-containing flooring within the existing Visitors Center at Montezuma National Wildlife Refuge prior to demolition. OSHA-compliant air sampling is also required. A site visit will be held at 10:00 AM on June 17, 2026.
