NAICS: 562211. THIS IS A TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE. The U.S. Department of the Air Force's 502nd Contracting Squadron seeks a contractor that can perform remediation cleaning services to mitigate lead buildup, carbon residue, in Building 950 of the Armory at Joint Base San Antonio-Chapman in San Antonio, Texas. Work will include conducting a site survey to assess the building's location and layout, conducting a comprehensive initial deep cleaning of the armory approximately 30 days after contract award, and cleaning all floors, walls, and ceilings, workspaces and tool cabinets, office desks, janitorial closet, latrine, weapons storage racks, wall lockers, and all air vents. Bi-annual maintenance shall take place every six months to ensure ongoing upkeep and operational efficiency. The contractor shall supply and install three HEPA air purification systems to optimize indoor air quality. The contractor shall designate an on-site project manager as the Site POC before the start of work, who will be the interface for all work site communications with the Government, including quality, safety, and discrepancy matters. The award will be a firm-fixed-price Purchase Order to the vendor who is determined to offer the best value to the Government. Questions are due by 1:00 PM CDT on June 23, 2026. OFFERS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN 1:00 PM CDT ON JULY 3, 2026.
