NAICS: 562211. THIS IS A SOURCES SOUGHT NOTICE FOR MARKETING RESEARCH PURPOSES ONLY. DOE's contractor, Hanford Tank Waste Operations and Closure LLC (H2C), requests proposals for treatment and disposal services for hazardous waste generated at the Hanford Site near Richland, Washington. The requested work is in support of H2C's Prime Contract 89303324DEM000096 with the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of River Protection. H2C manages the following facilities for the Department of Energy (DOE) Hanford Field Office (HFO): the Hanford 200E and 200W Tank Farms; and the 200E Effluent Treatment Facility (ETF) with associated facilities, including the 200E Liquid Effluent Retention Facility (LERF), the 200E Treated Effluent Disposal Facility (TEDF), and the 600 area State Approved Land Disposal Site (SALDS). H2C also provides hazardous waste management services for the Waste Treatment Plant (WTP)/Bechtel National Inc. (BNI) Hanford Site contractor and the Hanford Mission Integration Services (HMIS) contractor. H2C, HMIS and WTP facilities and projects may generate Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) hazardous waste, Washington State Dangerous Waste regulations (WAC 173-303), and/or Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) waste. The scope of work includes providing treatment, transportation, and disposal services for non-radiological hazardous (RCRA)/Washington State Dangerous, TSCA, non-regulated, universal, pharmaceutical, and recyclable/reclaimable waste generated at H2C Tank Farms, 200E ETF, WTP, and HMIS contractor facilities and projects. Services will include providing roll-offs for large-volume waste; Pack-on-Paper services for chemical and other waste cleanouts, including waste segregation, designation, profiling, process code assignment, and administrative tasks; and all personnel, transportation, facilities, technical expertise, testing, sampling, and process controls necessary for proper treatment and disposal. All transportation shall comply with applicable DOT (49 CFR) and DOE Site requirements, including DOE Motor Carrier Evaluation Program approval, dedicated licensed waste-hauling vehicles, and emergency response and spill/discharge requirements. The Buyer will provide support personnel to load the transporter. The award will be a firm-fixed-price contract. OFFERS ARE DUE BY 4:00 PM PDT ON AUGUST 27, 2026.
