NAICS: 562910. THE SOLICITATION WILL BE SET ASIDE 100% FOR SMALL BUSINESS under NAICS code 562910, size standard \$22M. The Department of the Air Force, Hill AFB, Utah, intends to make a single-award IDIQ asbestos abatement contract. The Contracting Officer anticipates awarding a firm-fixed-price contract of five years duration. The vast majority of the abatement projects will be at Hill AFB, with a small quantity of projects at Little Mountain, Utah Test and Training Range, Dugway, Carter Creek and other associated sites located in Utah and Pinedale, Wyoming. The government estimates that the volume of work will be between \$500.00 and \$9,997,129.28 during the performance period. The work will consist primarily of removal and disposal of asbestos and lead-based paint-containing materials, but may include heavy metals cleanup, mold remediation, and pigeon/rodent excrement cleanup. Task orders may include removal and re-installation of hard walls, hard ceilings, sub-flooring, suspended drop-in ceiling systems, pipes, various insulation materials, acoustical ceilings, etc. THE SOLICITATION WILL BE AVAILABLE ON OR ABOUT DECEMBER 28, 2020.
