




Major HUD soil lead documents

 - Chapter 15 Clearance
- Lead Safe Housing Rule: Covers HUDassisted and HUD-owned target housing
- EPA 403 standards (incorporated into LSHR)

NOTE: Check if Federal, state, or local laws and regulations apply. If so, follow them wherever they are more stringent. LSHR stands for Lead Safe Housing Rule (24 CFR 35 subparts B-R).




National surveys of lead in housing

 - 2005-2006; 1131 nationally representative housing units




AHHS Mean Soil, Bare Soil Pb (ppm)


All Occupied HUs




Soil Pb (ppm) by region




Soil Pb (ppm) by tenure




Soil Bare Soil Pb (ppm) by year built




Soil Bare Soil Pb (ppm) by year built with children <6 y




Spil Bare Soil Pb (ppm) by household income




Soil Pb (ppm) by Poverty




Soil Bare Soil Pb (ppm) by household income with children < 6 y




Soil Bare Soil Pb (ppm) by urbanization




Soil Bare Soil Pb (ppm) by Poverty by Urbanization




Bare Soil Pb (ppm) by Race
